

Exegetical Notes on Isaiah 45:22-25

Context: Chapter 45 begins with the commission to Cyrus, and God doing a new thing, using an outsider to save Israel. It continues with another “new thing” – that God is not going to save “just” Israel, but that salvation will also be available to the “nations”. We can talk about this as the kingdom of God, and the extension of that Kingdom. Verse 23 indicates that the whole world will be subject to God and his rule, but this extension to the “nations” is not the kingdom of power, but rather the kingdom of grace – and rather than be jealous over this turn in events, Israel will rejoice in the salvation and the reign of God.
