

Exegetical Notes on Luke 1:39-55

Immediately after the annunciation, without much comment Mary makes a 2-3 day trip from Nazareth to the hill country of Judea, tradition specifies the town in question to be Ain Karim, 5m W. of Jerusalem., although there is a Beth Zechariah about halfway [about 12m S.] between Jerusalem and Hebron, and as Hebron was a priestly city, this is yet another possibility. Another difficulty is a textual variant which attributes the Magnificat to Elizabeth, instead of Mary. Regardless of who spoke it, it is important to all the downtrodden servants of God, and has a rich liturgical history. One must carefully note the echos of the LXX in this text, and how these echos are developed later in the Gospel.
