"Immediately after the suffering of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of heaven will be shaken. Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see 'the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven' with power and great glory. And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. "From the fig tree learn its lesson: as soon as its branch becomes tender and puts forth its leaves, you know that summer is near. So also, when you see all these things, you know that he is near, at the very gates.

Parallel to Mark 13:24-31

σελήνη καὶ ἄστροις – 1x in NT, 4x in LXX –

Ps 135:9 τὴν σελήνην καὶ τὰ ἄστροα εἰς ἔξουσίαν τῆς νυκτός ὅτι εἰς τὸν αἰῶνα τὸ ἔλεος αὐτοῦ

136:9 the moon and stars to rule over the night, for his steadfast love endures for ever;

The earth quakes before them, the heavens tremble. The sun and the moon are darkened, and the stars withdraw their shining.

The moon in heaven, with the stars, does not stand so august as you, who, after lighting the way of your star-like seven sons to piety, stand in honor before God and are firmly set in heaven with them.

συναχῆ - 2x in NT, 5x in LXX – *a state of mental distress, involving acute anxiety -*

Lev 26:16 I will do this to you: I will appoint over you sudden terror, consumption, and fever that waste the eyes and cause life to pine away. And you shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it;

ἤχους – 4x in NT – *any type of sound, tone, or noise other than human speech - information concerning a person or an event* -

Luke 4:37 And reports of him went out into every place in the surrounding region.
